FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FEBRUARY 6, 2024

- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A: One vote per unit
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- A: Units may be occupied only as a permanent or transient residence.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium document on the leasing of my unit?
- A: Occupancy is limited by size of unit:
 - One bedroom/studio: 4 persons; Two bedrooms: 6 persons; Three bedrooms: 8 persons.
 - Short term rentals must be occupied by at least one person who is at least 25 years of age.
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A: For 2024, unit assessments are charged quarterly and range from \$1,460 to \$2,927 per quarter.
 - Assessments are due on January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1.
- Q: <u>Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?</u>
- A: All units are members of St. Thomas Square Master Owners Association, Inc. Units have one vote per unit. Assessments are included with the condominium assessments.
- Q: <u>Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?</u>
- A: No.
- Q: <u>Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association</u> involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case.
- A: No.
