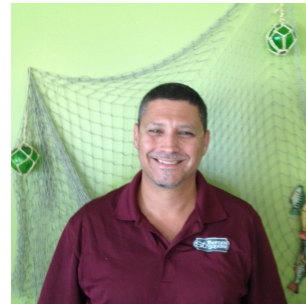
MOA Board Meeting
